

English

This half term, children will learn about prepositions and the prefix un. They will develop their sentence writing by using expanded noun phrases to add detail and description. We will also focus on using question marks and exclamation marks correctly before exploring speech and how it is represented in writing.

Religious Education

This half term, children will explore the topic of Dialogue and Encounter. They will learn about belonging to a Christian community, including the Church and parish, and understand the significance of the Sign of the Cross. Children will also be introduced to Judaism, learning about Jewish people and the Torah, while exploring how different faith communities live and worship.

Mathematics

This half term, children will develop their understanding of place value, exploring numbers and their value within tens and ones. They will then apply their maths skills to money, recognising coins and notes and solving simple practical problems. Finally, children will learn about time, including days, months and telling the time to the hour and half past.

DT

This half term, children will explore healthy eating through a range of practical food activities. They will taste and compare different fruits, learn how to prepare ingredients safely, and develop their food preparation skills through juicing. The unit will culminate in children designing and making their own delicious fruit smoothies.

Computing

We will continue developing our word processing skills to be able to type with accuracy, edit text as well as understanding the keyboard. We will focus on typing skills, moving the cursor and leaving finger spaces.

We will continue to discuss e-safety and the different ways we can stay safe online.

Science

This half term, children will learn about a variety of wild and garden plants and explore the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees. They will identify the main parts of plants, including roots, stems, leaves, flowers and seeds, and discover what plants need to grow and stay healthy. Through practical investigations, children will explore how seeds and bulbs grow and observe changes in plants over time.

Physical Education

This half term, children will develop their ball-chasing skills and floor-work balance through a range of activities. Using focused skill sessions, imaginative stories and games, they will improve their coordination, movement, balance and control while building confidence in physical activity.

Geography and History

Children will learn about the Human and Physical features of different seaside locations in the UK. They will look at similarities and differences between the town and the seaside.

In History, children will be finding out seaside holidays in the past and comparing with present day seaside locations.
